

ICD-9 CODES FOR POSSIBLE PHYSICIAN'S DIAGNOSIS AND LABORATORY TESTING

Insurance Claims require Diagnostic Codes and CPT Codes.

Below are the most common ICD-9 Diagnostic Codes. An ICD-9 Diagnostic Code is a numerical code designated by physicians for each diagnosis or possible diagnosis they assign to their patients for the Laboratory Testing being ordered. Diagnostic Codes are also referred to as ICD-9 Codes so Insurance and Medicare can simplify their Claim forms for lengthy words used in the diagnosis. Please note that each Laboratory Test provides many different types of possible diagnoses by a physician. Therefore, those listed below are the most commonly used for hair, saliva, urine and stool Laboratory tests according to our labs. For ICD-9 codes for blood testing, contact your physician for the ICD-9 code for each of the "diagnoses" you have received.

CPT Codes are also numerical codes. However, CPT Codes are assigned to Services, like Consultations, Examinations, Supplement Programs, Dietary Plans, etc. For example, the CPT Codes for Genova Diagnostic Lab are printed on the white REQUISITION sheet beside each Laboratory Test, and posted on our website is a list of CPT Codes for Clinical Nutrition and Dietary Therapies.
